Our sport is called "Predicted Log Racing," but it is actually a navigational contest where the competitors "predict" how long it will take them to get from point to point on the race course.

But one doesn't have to even own a boat to participate in predicted log races. At every event, each contestant needs to have a neutral "observer" on board. It is the observer's job to record the time in hours, minutes, and seconds at each control point and submit it to the scorekeeper at the end of the race. So whether you're a skipper, observer, or crew member, you'll have a fun day on the water and at the post-race gathering when the race results are dramatically revealed.
