



## Ventura Yacht Club Guest Dock Rules

Policies regarding the assignment of space, rules of conduct, administration, and operation of the Ventura Yacht Club guest dock shall be approved by the Ventura Yacht Club Board of Directors and implemented by the Marina Management Committee. Failure to fully comply with the guest dock rules will result in loss of privileges and removal from the guest dock.

1. Visiting yachtsmen wishing to use the guest dock facilities shall immediately apply for berthing by contacting the Waterfront Activities Manager, presenting proof of current club affiliation, current CF documentation & insurance, and completing a *Guest Dock Berthing Request Form*.
2. The use of our guest dock is a privilege extended to visiting yachtsmen from affiliated yacht clubs. The owner/captain of the visiting yacht shall be responsible for the conduct of crew and visitors. You, your crew, and any guests are expected to conduct yourselves with courtesy and decorum.
3. The Ventura Yacht Club is a “Clean Harbor” facility. Visiting yachtsmen are required to comply with provisions of this policy. If you are unfamiliar with the policy, the Waterfront Activities Manager will provide a copy to you. It includes, but is not limited to: flushing sewage into the harbor; oil and/or fuel spillage; and disposal of toxic chemicals into the harbor.
4. Club burgee shall be flown while at our guest dock.
5. Berthing boats at the guest dock for commercial purposes is prohibited. Charter, For Hire, and For Sale signs are prohibited.
6. Vessels shall be operated cautiously at no wake speed. Any damage to club facilities or other yachts shall be reported immediately to the Waterfront Activities Manager and the Ventura Harbor Patrol.
7. Pets shall be leashed and under control of the owner when off of the boat. Any disturbance of the peace or damage to property shall result in the removal of the pet, by the owner, from club facilities. Pet waste shall immediately be removed by the owner.
8. Docks shall be kept clean and free of clutter to enable unhampered passage for other guests or emergency personnel on the docks. Dinghies, kayaks, or other crafts and equipment may not be stored on the dock. Dock lines must be properly attached and coiled.
9. All power cords and connections to dock electric power shall meet marine and VYC standards per *Ventura Yacht Club Dock and Dry Storage Rules* (sc. 14).
10. Due to limited maneuvering room, the largest vessel that can be accommodated on the guest dock, without severely blocking access to the 30’ slips, is a vessel with a maximum beam of 16’. Vessels over this size will be accommodated only with prior approval from the Waterfront Activities Manager and if conditions outlined in Section 26 of the *Ventura Yacht Club Dock and Dry Storage Rules* are adhered to.
