



Program Guide:

When your child begins to combine the mechanics of upwind & downwind sailing, fleet tactics, and an understanding of the Racing Rules of Sailing, they may be ready to attend a Green Fleet regatta. Designed for novice sailors and racers, the Green Fleet's practices and races provide the building blocks to fine-tune not only a youth's racing skills, but sailing skills in general. The introduction to a sports team and the sailing community grants incredible growth and opportunities for youth sailors by providing the foundation for one's sailing skills as well as personal connections and relationships with fellow sailors.

Pre-requisites & Commitment:

Green Fleet racers must join the Ventura Yacht Club as Junior Members and are expected to attend weekly practices and to participate in the six annual *Carrie Series* races planned by the Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association (SCYYRA). **Attendance of both practices and regattas is mandatory to transition to the Optimist Champ Fleet.**

Tuition/Structure:

Practices will be hosted twice a week from 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM. **Practice and regatta fees are non-refundable.** Tuition and registration are utilized to plan for the Term, and we cannot adjust the program once tuition has been paid.
